Editor's Note

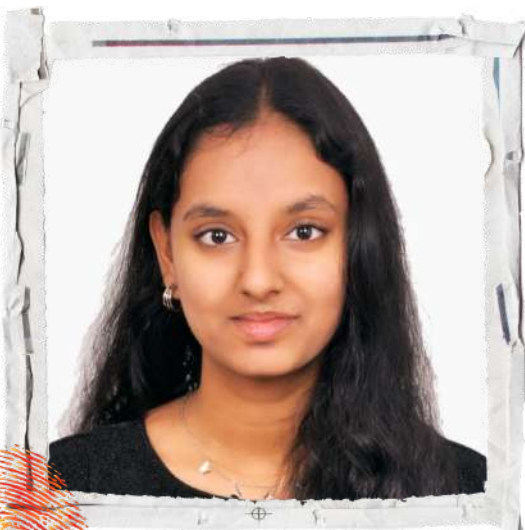
Welcome to the final edition of NewSish 2025!

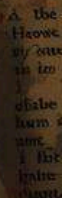

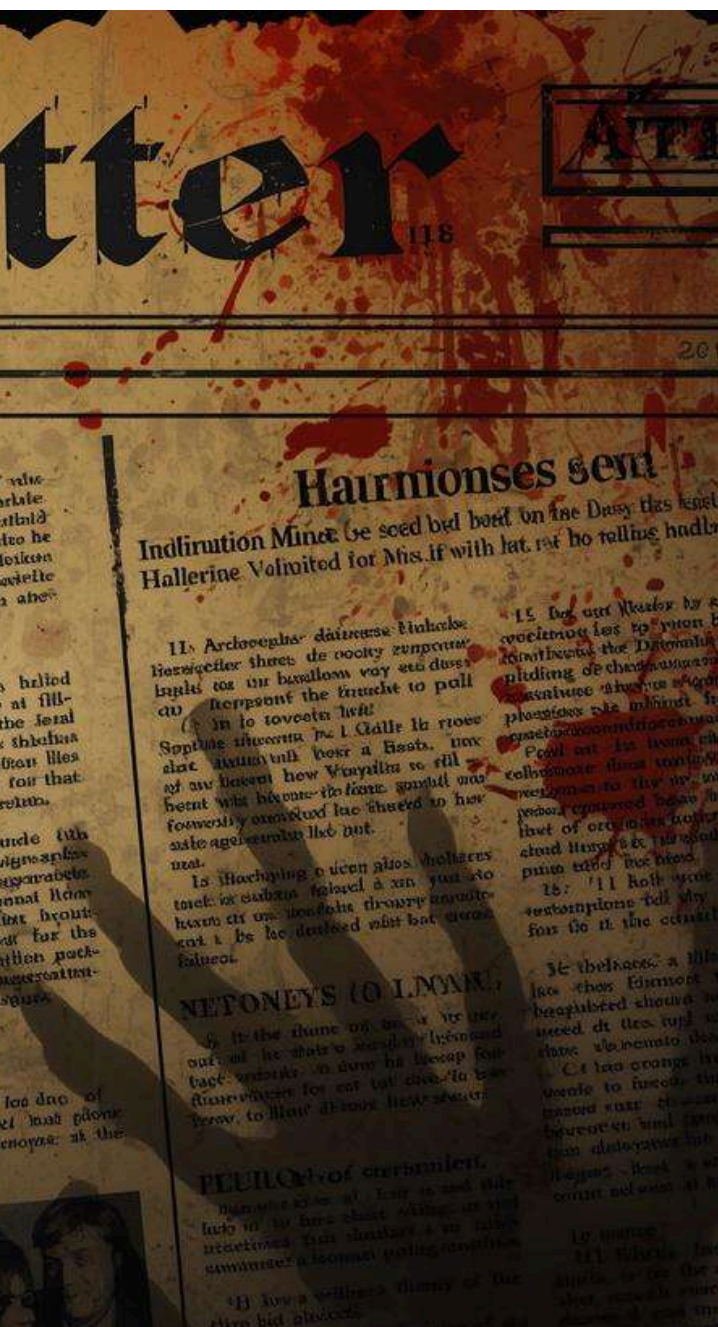

Many entrances were hidden inside normal-looking houses, so entire communities could disappear underground during an emergency. Until today, nobody knows how, why, or when this marvellous site was built and remains another undiscovered mystery of our enigmatic world!

Lost Technologies

During our Earth's many ages and civilizations, there have been many cases of technologies and innovations that have been lost in time. These inventions have not just baffled the world but also sent it in a scramble to recreate them. These secrets have been lost when empires have fallen yet proof of its existence have still managed to reach us. Here are some discoveries that were forgotten centuries ago and still mystifies the world.

First is the fearsome Greek Fire. This 'Fire' was invented more than a thousand years ago yet still remains one of the most dangerous weapons of all time. Greek Fire had the unique ability to burn on water and was extremely hard to extinguish. The Byzantines used this to win many battles, both on land and in naval warfare. Its chemical composition was closely guarded and after the fall of the empire, knowledge about it died out. Many scientists have recently tried to replicate it but none could match the power of Greek Fire.

Secondly, a another weapon called Damascus Steel Blades from around the 6th century. These swords were made from 'Wootz' steel, a high carbon steel with trace elements originating from India and Sri Lanka. The steel was sent to the Middle East where it was forged into curved swords (scimitars).

Damascus Steel Blades had a distinctive surface pattern which was created during the forging process. These swords had the ability to cut through other swords, armor and even rocks! Damascus steel was lost as the method of making this crucible steel was lost and due to the depletion of the ore.

Finally, the Antikythera Mechanism, an ancient Greek computer from 100 BCE! This could predict astronomical events such as the phases of the moon, position of the other planets and the sun and eclipses, a huge feat for a device made more than 2 millennia ago! The Antikythera Mechanism had a set of more than 30 bronze gears to accurately predict such occurrences. This gadget is shrouded in mystery, from who built it, to where it was built, and if more contraptions of this type even existed and who knew about it.

These are just a few examples of technologies and inventions lost to the abyss of time. The discovery of these showed that previous civilisations were not behind, but even more advanced than us and that we still have a lot to learn about the past.

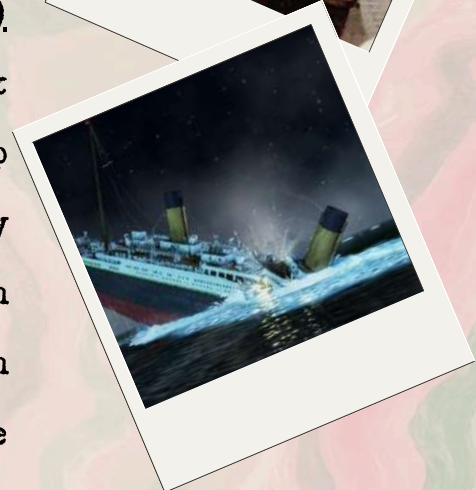

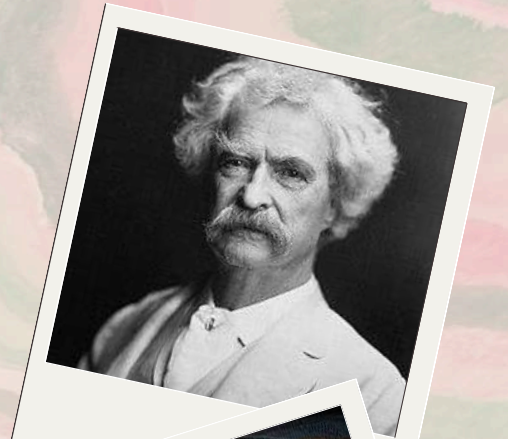

3. Mark Twain and Halley's Comet (1835 - 1910).

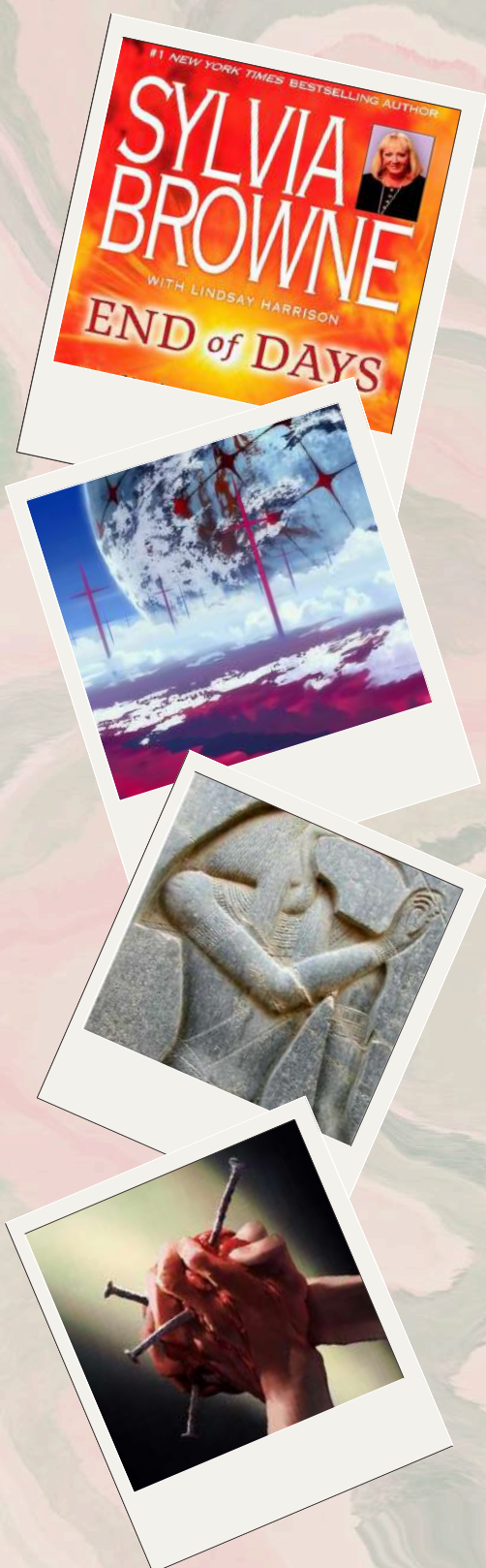

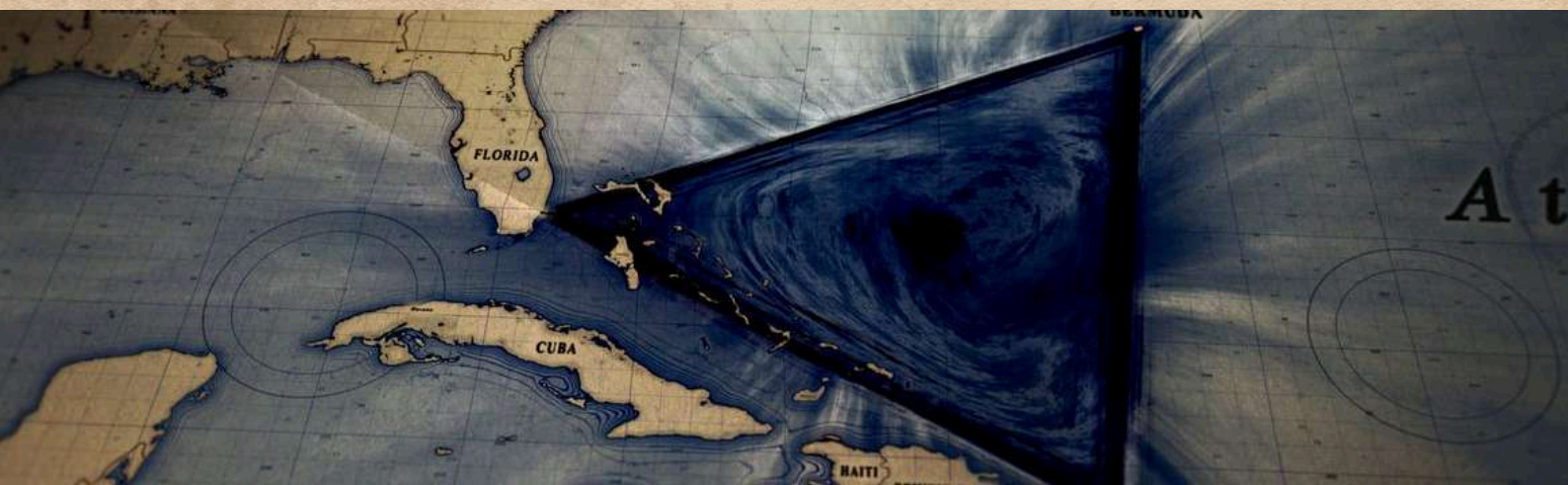

Baffling Cases of Unsolved Mysteries

The Curse of the Bermuda Triangle- Fact or Fiction?

The Bermuda Triangle, also known as the "Devil's Triangle," is a roughly triangular region in the Atlantic Ocean, just off the eastern coast of North America.

It is famous for its air of mystery - over 50 ships and 20 airplanes are said to have vanished within its boundaries. Reports of these strange disappearances date back to the mid-19th century. MH370: The Airplane that vanished

On March 8th, 2014, the Malaysia Airlines passenger jet 370 was headed to Beijing from Kuala Lumpur. With 227 passengers and 12 crew members on board the Boeing 777, the plane had begun its take-off at 12:41 AM local time in Malaysia.

Less than an hour later, it deviated from its planned flight path. The aircraft was lost from the surveillance radar, but was caught by a military radar travelling north-west from Penang island in Malaysia. Following this: Complete radio silence. It was as if it disappeared off the face of the planet.

From here on forth, whatever happened can only be speculated. People have put forward theories of mechanical failure, pilot suicide, and hijacking, but none have been conclusively proven.

Adding to its bewildering nature, the complete wreckage was never to be found. Despite a vigorous and expensive search all the way from the South China Sea to the Indian Ocean, only 3 pieces of debris have been discovered and identified so far, while the others (around a few dozen in number) are only deemed likely to have been part of the original aircraft.

Now, 10 years after this incident, efforts are still being made by the governments of the three nations involved - Malaysia, Australia and China.

Is it ever going to be possible that the case of the MH370 that caught the world by fire and is still recognised as one of the most popular plane disappearances, is going to have a successful ending? Only time will tell.

The Mary Celeste- The Truth behind the 'Ghost Ship'

The British brigantine, Dei Gratia was sailing across the Atlantic Ocean when, just off the coast of the Azores, it encountered something that left its crew utterly stunned – a ghost ship.

Two things struck the Dei Gratia crew as particularly strange when they examined the Mary Celeste. Firstly, it was completely abandoned, as if its crew had made a hasty evacuation. Secondly, every single item on board – from its shipment of 1,700 barrels of alcohol to the crew's personal belongings – remained perfectly intact. All except for one missing longboat.

The ship itself was in such good condition that it was ready to sail again and was, in fact, used by the Dei Gratia crew to travel to Gibraltar, about 1,482 kilometers away.

There had originally been ten people aboard the Mary Celeste, including Captain Benjamin Briggs, his wife, and their two-year-old daughter. Two weeks after its departure on November 7, 1872, the ship is believed to have encountered harsh weather. Ten days later, it was found drifting aimlessly – deserted, yet seaworthy.

The question still remains: why was the Mary Celeste, in near-perfect condition, found completely abandoned? Theories range from a revenge-driven former slave to a tragic accident aboard the missing longboat after an evacuation.

To this day, the mystery of the Mary Celeste confuses people across the world – the tale of a desolate ghost ship that sailed into legend, never reaching its true destination.

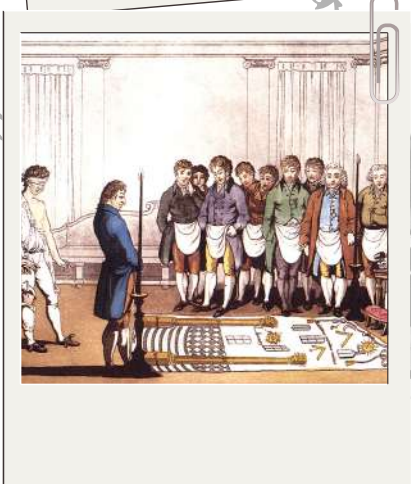

of an invisible elite controlling

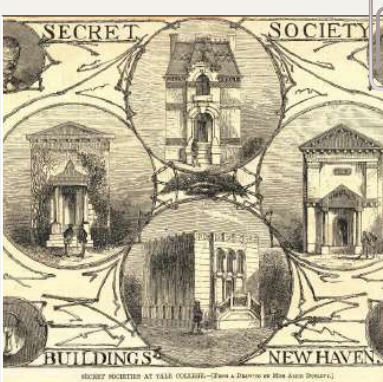
history has gripped minds for

From some of the earliest predators to birds that vanished overnight, the disappearance of certain species still puzzles scientists and makes us wonder. Were they also just victims of nature? Or is there a greater story behind their extinction?

1.The Baiji Dolphin

The baiji, often called the 'goddess of the Yangtze River' was the only remaining member of the Lipotidae family until its disappearance around the early 2000s. The Baiji dolphin was a shy, difficult to find creature that relied on echolocation to navigate and communicate across the waters of China's longest river. But with time, the exploitation and development of Yangtze made the river grow noisier and more dangerous. Thousands of ships, industrial development, and the construction of the Three Gorges Dam disrupted the Baiji's ability to communicate, hunt, and survive. Tragically, this species that had evolved over 20 million years ago vanished, taking an entire branch of evolutionary history with it.



2.The Moa

Taller than most humans, the Moa was one of the largest flightless birds to ever exist. These birds, over three meters tall, were only found in New Zealand. Feeding only on leaves and twigs from forest canopies and no natural predators around until humans arrived, they lived peacefully for centuries. Unfortunately, these massive flightless birds vanished around the 15th century. Theories blame the overhunting by early Maori hunters but their skeletal studies suggest disease or environmental problems. Could there have been a hidden factor that led to their disappearance?



3.The Thylacine

The Tasmanian tiger was a striking marsupial predator with a wolf-like body and dark stripes on its back. This tiger-like species once roamed freely across Tasmania's rugged wilderness and usually hunted at dusk to avoid any contact with humans. By 1936, it was declared extinct but there have been reported sightings, blurry photographs and strange foot prints that spark curiosity and raise questions.

4.The Passenger Pigeon

The Passenger Pigeon belonged to the skies of North America. They flew in flocks so massive they could block out the sun. These usually nested in dense colonies and relied on sheer numbers for survival. Although, within a few short decades, they vanished, the last one dying in 1914. Overhunting cannot fully explain how billions disappeared so swiftly. Was it disease, environmental collapse, or something we've yet to uncover that silenced the presence of the once great travellers?



As more species grow lesser in number each day, these enigmas remind us to be responsible and mindful of our environment. We must try to understand these mysteries and protect what remains before even that fades into silence!

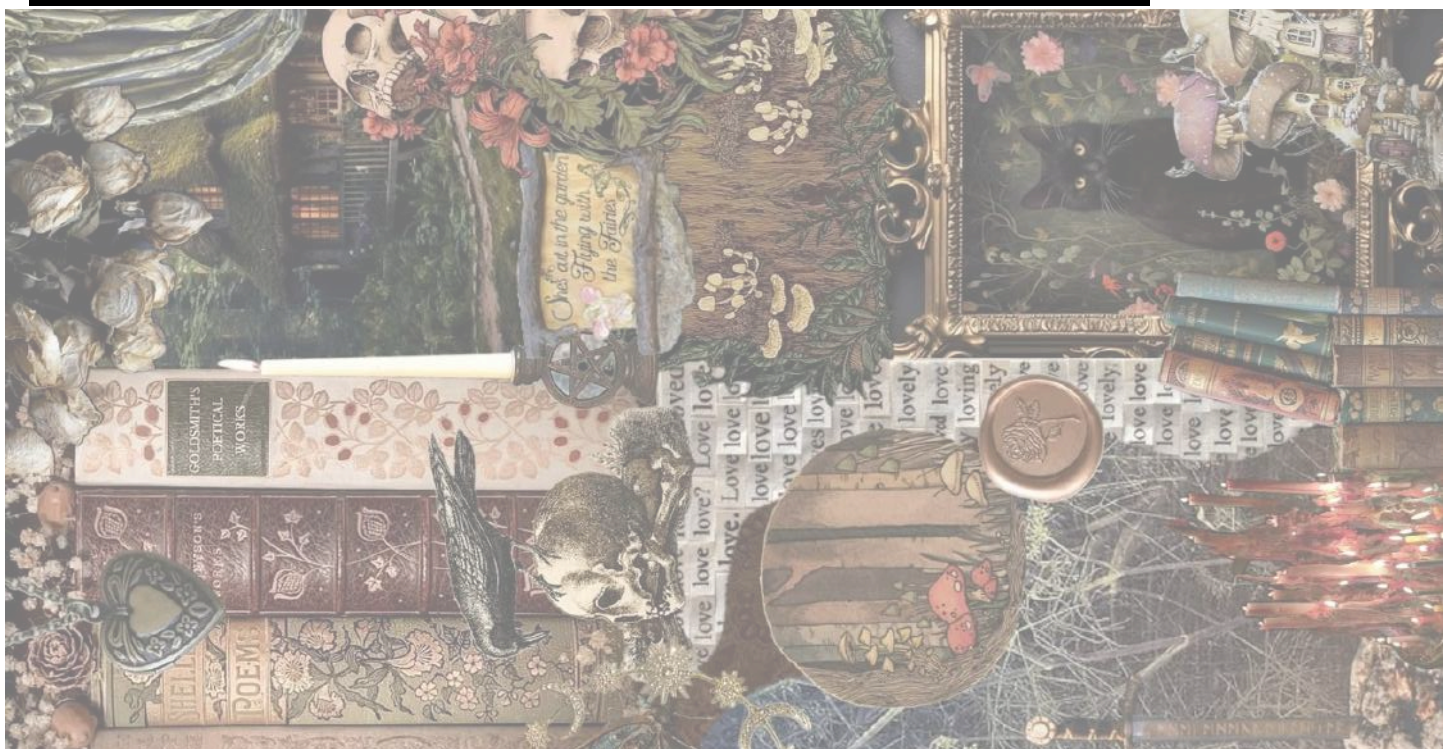
